

Average Processing Times - WEBSITE

Below is a chart summarizing the average processing times we are experiencing at our office in cases where a request for more evidence is not issued. The below timeframes are based recent approvals we have received and should only be used as a general reference.

Type of Case	Estimated Processing Times After Applications Are Filed with Immigration
Renewal of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)	1 – 5 months
Parole in Place / Deferred Action (Based on family in the US Armed Forces)	9 – 12 months
Applications for Employment Authorization Document (EAD)	3 – 6 months NOTE: This is an average Processing Time for EAD's based on Asylum, Adjustment, Parole in Place, Deferred Action, U Visa.
U Visa Petition	2 – 3 years for Waitlist 4 ½ – 5 years for Approval
U Visa Adjustment of Status	9 – 12 months
Family Based Adjustment of Status	9 – 12 months
Family Petition – Immediate Relative	1 – 12 months
Provisional Unlawful Presence Waiver	9 – 12 months
Consular Processing	<u>Wait Times for Immigrant Visa Interview Date at Consulate:</u> - Mexico = 12 – 18 months - El Salvador = 2 – 6 months - Honduras/Guatemala/Nicaragua = 6 – 8 months NOTE: Processing Times vary because the National Visa Center processes cases based on country
Resident Alien Card - After Immigrant Visa Approval and Immigrant Fee is paid online	3 – 9 months
Petition to Remove Conditions on Residency	12 – 15 months

Resident Alien Card Renewal / Replacement	4 – 14 months
Application for Naturalization	6 – 9 months
Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS)	1. Child Custody: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- North Carolina = 4 – 8 months- South Carolina = 6 – 9 months 2. SIJS Petition = 6 – 9 months 3. Wait for Priority Date to become Current: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- See Visa Bulletin listed on our website 4. Adjustment of Status: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Applications with USCIS = 9 – 12 months- Applications in Immigration Court = 6 – 12 months
